7.1 Bachelor of Arts in Journalism

- 7.1.1 Malawi School Certificate of Education (MSCE) or its equivalent, with a minimum of six credit passes in the best six subjects (including English and Mathematics) to start in Year 1.
- 7.1.2 Diploma in Journalism or related qualification from a recognised Institution with a minimum of two years of work experience in relevant field and MSCE with four credit passes including English to start in Year 2.

7.2 Diploma in Journalism

- 7.2.1 Certificate in journalism or its equivalent or any related higher qualification from a recognized institution.
- 7.2.2 Those with an equivalent tertiary qualification must provide a proof of their journalism work such as an article in a publication or a recorded TV/Radio program.

7.3 Certificate in Journalism

Malawi School Certificate of Education (MSCE), with at least four credits including English and should have an interest in current affairs and passion for writing.
